

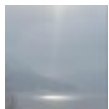

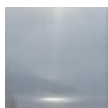
So, basically, you scare me, in the same way spiders do...can't stop watching them, they fascinate me! Looking forward to spending time in your web!

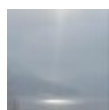

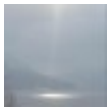
