If that doesn't make it into some lexicon of quotations, there is simply no justice in this world.

Truly, this is the kind of intellectual riffing on sex that a reader can expect from Supervert (or rather, Mercury de Sade) in Extraterrestrial sex fetish. This is what sets it apart from the usual Virgin Megastore 'hip books' department pop-lit offerings. It is actually *good*. *ETSF* actually has profound thought interspersed with its sci-fi sex perversions. If you are a thinker or a pervert (or ideally both) --*ETSF* will entertain.

ETSF acknowledges that the proclivities of extraterrestrials, if they even exist, are an unknown variable. Rather, what *ETSF* actually does is examine the human sexual experience from various extraterrestrial/exophilosophical points of entry...er...orifices. For this reason alone, I highly recommend it. The sophisticated (if somewhat sexually twisted) reader will probably enjoy more than one 'chuckle out loud' moments. I know I did.

ETSF is ingeniously devised using a mathematical arrangement that allow the user to select his or her experience. The imagined ET sex scenes and the Ninfa sexploitation narrative are interspersed with relevant presentations of the history of exophilosophy - from Descartes to Barthes - which are actually quite well considered and thought provoking. However, it is quite tempting after the first few to skip ahead to the naughty bits, which evoke a prurient "I can't believe I'm reading this...but it's kind of HOT" response. Er...or...maybe that was just me. The alien who can lick your balls while you sodomize her just really caught my attention, I guess.

If I had a criticism of this book it would be that it is perhaps too honest. The author has many good laughs at the expense of delusional messianic UFO seekers. However, I actually think exophilia (desire to have sex with aliens of pleasure from thoughts about doing so) is a viable proclivity - no different from any we might discuss here at Lust. Perhaps the author might consider pseudonymously publishing a collection of ET erotica, and marketing it to those who would happily latch on to such a thing. We featured the "Gorean" fetish here on Lust - in which fans of the Gor books adopt a 'Gorean' fetish lifestyle. The 'furies' don fuzzy costumes, meet and fuck at grand conventions worldwide. Trekkies and Sci-Fi fans already hook up at conventions. Is it so hard to imagine them donning latex green suits with all manner of imagined orifice s? Or have we missed the curve--perhaps there are already call girls and dominatrixes who imitate the most popular sci-fi characters. In fact, this seems likely. Could *real* exophiliacs put aside the philosophical conflict in *ETSF*, much like the way homosexuals ignore the portions of the Bible that condemn them, and make *ETSF* the exophilic equivalent of *The Story of Our 120 Days of Sodom*? We shall see.

Regardless, *Extraterrestrial Sex Fetish* is one of the most thought provoking books about sexuality that I've ever had the distinct pleasure of reading - and I highly recommend it to Satanists as well as anyone interested in off-the-beaten path explorations of sexuality.
